- This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of community settings and clients homes, who provide training and support in a manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self reliance, community participation and wellbeing. Workers promote a person centred approach, work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a small team.

The Key Features of this Program are:

- This program is designed to provide training for people to enhance their continued education and employment prospects through the development of skills and knowledge.
- Students have access to hands on training in a simulated environment, well preparing them for success and alleviating any stress associated to using equipment before entering the workforce.
- This program enables students to gain practical experience working in an environment that cares for people with disabilities. This provides opportunities for students to consolidate their learning.

- Disability Officer
- Senior Care Assistant
- Supervisors

The entry requirements for this program are:

- Classroom face to face sessions lead by a trainer
- Student lead learning – reading learning material
- Practical experience in simulated environment
- Collaborative learning – classroom discussions

- Demonstration of knowledge through a combination of written, practical and oral assessments
- Demonstration of activities in an appropriately simulated environment, in an appropriate range of situations
